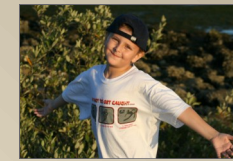

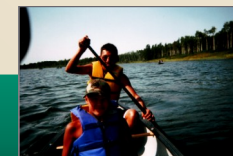

## Who We Are

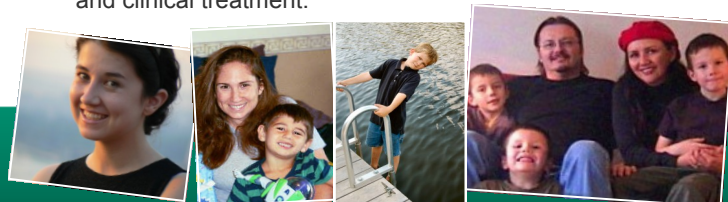
